



“ Threat Assessment / Risk Assessment / Risk Treatment ”

Shelby Enterprises starts at the beginning as you cannot conduct a risk assessment unless you know the threats to the area and the business to draft a risk assessment and a risk treatment plan.

Threat Assessment

Shelby Enterprises divides these threats into three categories: outsiders, insiders, and outsiders in collusions with insiders.

If you do not know what your threats were for the past two years, what your current threats are and what the new threats will be, how can you defend your area? Once we have a clear idea of what these threats are, we then move into the risk assessment.

Risk Assessment

Risk assessment is a necessary part of your risk management.

Shelby Enterprises' risk assessment takes a thorough look at your workplace / living space to identify the situations, processes, etc that may cause harm; particularly to people. After identification is made, we analyse and evaluate how likely the event will happen, and what the impact of the risk of an event arising from a threat or vulnerability will be, then we define critical functions / controls necessary to be in place in order to reduce the exposure.

In general, we look at the following:

- Preventing an incident by detecting it before it is underway
- Protecting against an attack
- Reducing (mitigating) the consequences

Risk Treatment

Shelby Enterprises will provide you with a risk treatment plan which is the action you need to take to manage the risk. The four risk treatment elements are:

- Avoidance
- Reduction
- Transfer
- Acceptance
